ELIGIBILITY

The Fence Show is open to all artists over the age of 18. Only original artwork will be accepted, photo reproductions are not acceptable. Only crafts of the highest caliber will be accepted into the show. Crafts must be handmade, not mass-produced, and please no garage sale items. The Staten Island Museum reserves the right to reject work deemed unsuitable by Museum staff.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Fees listed on the application are for a 12-foot space, maximum of two artist per space. Please indicate the number of 12-foot spaces you will need and whether you need a **fence or freestanding space** (freestanding exhibitors should bring their own tables and hanging racks). Requests are fulfilled on a *first-come first-served basis*. If the Fence Show is canceled in its entirety due to weather, there will be a 50% fee refund.

EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

The morning of the show each artist must set up their display between 9:00am-10:30am using their own materials (this includes any tables needed). All hanging artwork must be framed; any unframed pieces may be displayed in portfolio stands. Protruding displays that obstruct walkways or other spaces, signage that exceeds 30" in any dimension and the playing of music will not be permitted. Artists are encouraged to offer works for sale. The Museum charges no commission, and artists are responsible for the collection of any applicable sales tax. Artists are responsible for the protection and security of their own works and the removal of their own litter during and after the event.

PROMOTION

The Staten Island Museum will promote the **Fence Show** through media releases, program calendar, radio announcements, invitation and online.
