ELIGIBILITY

The Fence Show is open to all artists. Returning this year is our Junior Division for artists age 8-18 years old. Only original artwork will be accepted, photo reproductions are not acceptable. Only crafts of the highest caliber will be accepted into the show. Crafts must be handmade, NOT MASS PRODUCED, and please no garage sale items.

REQUIREMENT

Include with your application, an 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper with four thumbnails, representative of the body of work that you will be exhibiting. The Staten Island Museum reserves the right to reject work deemed unsuitable.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Fees listed on the application are for a 12' space, maximum of two artist per space. Please indicate the number of 12' spaces you will need and whether they are a **fence or freestanding space** (no tables or chairs are provided). If the Fence Show is canceled in its entirety due to weather, 50% of the fee for the space is refunded, not including membership fees.

EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

Show set up is between 9:00am - 10:30am. All hanging artwork must be framed when applicable; any unframed pieces may be displayed in portfolio stands. Protruding displays that obstruct walkways or other spaces, signage that exceeds 30" in any dimension and the playing of music is not permitted. Artists are encouraged to offer works for sale. The Museum charges no commission, artists are responsible for the collection of all applicable sales tax. Artists are responsible for the protection and security of their own works and the removal of all trash at 5pm.

PROMOTION

The Staten Island Museum will promote the **Fence Show** through media releases, program calendar, radio announcements and online. To get to Snug Harbor take the S40 Bus from the Staten Island Ferry, ask to be dropped off at the Snug Harbor Road bus stop.
